In early 2020, Rena Bishop was diagnosed with Stage 4 Triple Negative Metastatic Breast Cancer. This cancer is extremely aggressive, develops secondary formations outside of the initial and primary sites, and is currently incurable. In extreme attempts to broadcast the most genuine meaning behind "fight with all of your might," we would like to invite you to the fourth annual Rena Bishop Broadbill Bash fishing tournament. All proceeds will be donated to the local John H. "Jack" Burbage, Jr. Regional Cancer Care Center.

With both parents in the Navy, Rena experienced life in several places. In 1999, she moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland to pursue a degree in Computer Science and Business at the University of MD Eastern Shore. In making the decision to reside in Ocean City, life became tough. Through these times, she demonstrated the importance of recognizing life struggles, understanding the ability to overcome hardships, and finding a home in those who surround you.

My mission in founding this tournament is to express the importance in fighting to live, instead of living to die. Everyone in life serves a purpose, and I do not plan on leaving this Earth without serving mine. This is my next chapter, my chance to remind people to give it all you have got. It's important that people remember to keep smiling. I always have been and always will be, no matter where I end up ."-Rena Bishop

Rena was a valued employee of Sunset Grille for 10 years. With the restaurant being located at Sunset Marina, fishing soon became a lifestyle for Rena, allowing her to travel the world, expand her horizons, and truly feel more alive than ever before. OVER \$80,000 HAS BEEN RAISED TO DATE!

A Regional Cancer Care Center that serves Worcester County and the surrounding area was an idea that had been in the works for many years. It was developed based upon the unique needs of the community, a decade's worth of cancer research and support by the Campaign for the Future. The vision for what is now the John H. "Jack" Burbage, Jr. Regional Cancer Care Center was one convenient and centrally located, close-to-home facility for the comprehensive care and treatment of individuals with cancer and blood disorders.

Research shows cancer as a leading cause of death in the United States. In Maryland and Delaware the incidence of cancer is higher than the national average. Even more concerning, the mortality rate for Worcester and Sussex County residents diagnosed with cancer is nearly 10 percent higher than for the state of Maryland.


In June of 2017, construction for the 18,000 square-foot center commenced. Just over one year later, on June 27, 2018, the center welcomed its first patients. The John H. "Jack" Burbage, Jr. Regional Cancer Care Center combines personalized care and advanced technology, allowing patients to focus on their healing, while caregivers at the center coordinate to help them move smoothly through the steps of their cancer diagnosis and treatment, all while staying close to home.


In addition to previously available medical oncology and chemotherapy infusion services and integrative therapies, the center includes radiation oncology; PET/CT imaging; laboratory services; community education and support facilities; and telemedicine technology that allow patients and their physicians to consult with other cancer care experts at the University of Maryland Greenebaum Cancer Center, preventing unnecessary travel for consultation and follow-up care for patients who may require more intensive cancer care services.

What began as an idea, a wish really, has become a reality. With hard work and the generous philanthropic support of our community, our friends, family and neighbors now have access to the best in cancer care right here in Worcester County.


